# Remote Zanskar with Khandro Thrinlay Chodon

8<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> June 2023

## 20 days & 19 nights - ex Manali (arrival) and Delhi (return)

Wednesday 07/06/2023 or prior

Pilgrims will arrive in Delhi on or before this day to prepare for their journey to Manali by flight or car. This is arranged either privately or through SSDT/Druk Expeditions as an extra. The pilgrimage starts in Manali on 8th June.

#### Thursday 08/06/2023 Day 1

First gathering of our group will be at lunch in the hotel restaurant. Here you will be introduced to Khandro Rinpoche and other guides, given an introduction to the area and our journey together.

After lunch we will visit the famous Hadimba temple, built in 1553 over a large rock which was worshipped as an image of the deity Hadimbi Devi of the Indian epic The Mahabharata. Later we explore and enjoy coffee in Old Manali then walk through cedar forest back into main town. Dinner and early night. Overnight stay at Aloka Resort. Lunch and dinner included.

#### Friday 09/06/2023 Day 2

Day visit to the Shakya Shri hermitages of Kardang and Peukar. We depart early morning for the 2 hours drive through the new mountain tunnel into the sacred Dakini land of Garsha aka Lahoul. Breakfast will be had on the way or on arrival in Peukar and will be followed by meditation, a special puja and lunch. After we visit the birthplace of Khandro Rinpoche, Kardang Gompa for tea and again meet the Shakya Shri yogis and yoginis. Late we head back to Manali. Overnight stay at Aloka Resort. Breakfast, lunch and dinner is included

#### Saturday 10/06/2023 Day 3

Morning time we gather for meditation and yoga session. Later we drive along the Beas river to the ancient capital of the region, Naggar where we have lunch and visit the 500 year old Naggar Castle as well as the art gallery/museum of the famous Russian naturalist and explorer Nicholas Roerich.

Overnight stay at Aloka Resort. Breakfast/dinner at Aloka Resort. Lunch at Naggar included.

#### Sunday 11/06/2023 Day 4

It is a beautiful walk through the forest and down the hill past ancient Manali homes before we arrive at HH Shabdrung Rinpoche and Khandro Rinpoche's home Druk Zimkhang. Here you will feel the power and presence of His Holiness and see the active dharma hub it is today due to the ongoing blessing of Khandro Rinpoche. You will meet the Bhutanese caretakers, the children mentored by Khachodling and the very happy and active Khachodling ladies group. Puja will be held on this day. During this day we will also visit a nearby holy Shiva temple. Overnight stay at Aloka Resort. Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

#### Monday 12/06/2023

Today we will prepare for tomorrow's departure to remote Zanskar. You may choose to visit the nearby Vashist village with its hot springs or take a waterfall walk (half day activity). You may also choose to visit town for last minute shopping before heading to remote Zanskar..

Overnight stay at Aloka. Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

### Tuesday 13/06/2023

Early departure for the long day drive into the high Himalayas to remote Zanskar. The new tunnel has opened this area so it may be reached now in around 7-8 hours rather than 30 hours!

Overnight stay at Potala Guesthouse in Padum.

## Wednesday 14/06/2023

Rest day at Zanskar Overnight stay at Potala Guesthouse in Padum Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

### Thursday 15/06/2023

Long life wang (empowerment) and teaching for entire community by Khandro Rinpoche. This empowerment is special - it is of the divine mother Tara and Dsendali from Togden Shakya Shri. This historic event is hosted by the local "Kanishka Cultural Preservation and Welfare Association" as part of the inauguration of the recently completed Phodrang (palace) in memory of His Holiness the 9th Shabdrung. This is the first time this special empowerment is being bestowed by the female lineage holder and is the first time she has offered it to such a large crowd.

#### Sunday 18/06/2023 Day 11

Day of puja and celebrations with the nuns of Sani Khachodling hermitage. Due to covid their Spiritual Director Khandro Rinpoche has not been able to visit for some years. Sani Kangyur Festival continues Overnight at Khachodling hermitage in Sani Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

## Monday 19/06/2023

Day 12 Today we visit Zangla Khar, a 10th century palace/castle and Thongde monastery the 11th century Gelugpa gompa with with its ancient wall paintings. In addition we visit Karsha Gompa, the largest gompa in Zanskar Overnight at Khachodling hermitage in Sani Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

### Tuesday 20/06/2023

For your last full day in Zanskar we will make an early departure so we see the famous Phuktal Monastery. This day you may trek a few hours or if you prefer you can travel by horse to this magical monastery which is built into the rock and whose caves were said to have been retreat home to the 16 arhats who were legendary followers of Buddha.

Travel by car to Tso Pema (approx. 3 hrs) where you will stay the next 2 nights. In the afternoon explore the village area and the famous lake created by Guru Rinpoche! This area is renowned to the Tibetan Buddhist community. It is a small rural town will a holy lake and many monasteries surrounding it and more recently a large Guru Rinpoche statue is built overlooking the lake.

#### Monday 26/06/2023 Day 19

On this day you will travel above the lake where there are many caves renowned for retreat and with a very famous Guru Rinpoche cave you can visit. A good place also to raise prayer flags on this hilltop. We may take a picnic lunch and share it in the beautiful forest or hilltop above.

## Dates

The pilgrimage starts in Manali on 8th and concludes on 27th when you are dropped at your departure accomodation early evening of 27th June.

**Arrival to Manali by Flight** leaves delhi early morning of the 8th. Arrive at airport at 4am for the Alliance Air flight 9I 805 to Kullu via Chandigarh. Departs 6.05am arrives 8.15am. You will be met at Buntar airport. In Kullu and transferred by taxi to your hotel in Manali (approx 1 hr drive) where you may rest and settle into your hotel room with Himalayan view.

**Arrival to Manali by Car or Bus** - Manali is approx 10-12 hrs drive from Delhi so you will need to travel to Manali on 7th.

The bus leaves early evening and arrives by around 9am where you will be picked up and transferred to our pilgrimage hotel. If travelling by by car you can travel by day and /or by night to arrive at Aloka resort my lunchtime on 8th. We would rather suggest you arrive early evening of 7th so you have a good nights rest before our first gathering at lunch. Transport can be arranged by our travel agents Druk Expeditions.

**Costs** - \$4500AUD for 20 days ex Manali (arrival on 8th June) and Delhi (departure on evening of 27th June). Based on twin sharing accomodation and all transport and meals included as per the itinerary. Single supplement is \$75AUD or \$50USD per day.
